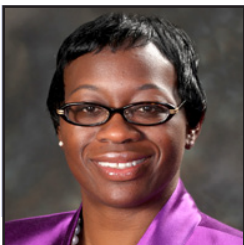

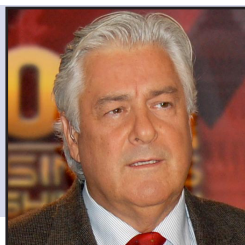
**Hector Villagra** Executive Director of the ACLU/ SC and formally, regional counsel and staff attorney for Mexican American Legal Defense and Educational Fund.
